In 2014, new, non-toxic, catalysts were evaluated and approved as substitutes for the mercury catalysts in selected number of formulations. In 2015 Crosslink continued to research alternatives to mercury. By finding substitute catalysts, were able to reduce the use of the mercury in new formulations by 2kg per year. Research in developing replacement of the mercury in many of the existing formulations is now complete and being sent to existing customers for approval in their process.
